


- you think stripping is something you do to a terrier.

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



AKC Opposes Proposed Mandatory Spay and Neuter Ordinance in Chicago

The American Kennel Club® (AKC®) and its member club the International Kennel Club of Chicago (IKC) oppose the decision of the Chicago City Council to consider a mandatory spay/neuter ordinance requiring all dogs and cats to be spayed or neutered unless the animal qualifies for a specific exemption. The Chicago City Council Committee on Finance is holding a joint hearing with the Committee on License and Consumer Protection today at 10 a.m. [July 30, 2008] to discuss this proposed law.

IKC's Show Chairman Susan Olsen will be reading a statement from IKC President Louis Auslander, past president and chairman of the board of the American Kennel Club. She will also be available for media interviews at the hearing.

Passage of this ordinance will negatively impact responsible dog breeders and owners. It will make it almost impossible for Chicago residents to purchase a healthy, well-bred pet from a local breeder.

Chicago Ordinance Update Wednesday, July 30, 2008

"Yesterday, a vote by the Chicago City Council's Finance Committee, in consideration of a proposed mandatory spay/neuter ordinance, was put off by committee chairman Alderman Ed Burke. After several hours of testimony, Alderman Burke delayed a vote to allow more testimony to be heard. No new hearing date has been set.

AKC's Government Relations Department continues to actively monitor developments regarding the Chicago ordinance proposal, and continues to work with responsible dog breeders and owners in the Chicago area in opposition to this unreasonable and unenforceable proposal.
